

Mougins School

Academic and pastoral support in the event of pupil absence, waiting for a test, or result, in isolation, or if having tested Covid+.

Secondary School

Academic

In the event that a student tests positive, but is not unwell, and thus self-isolating, or is self-isolating waiting for a test, or test result, and thus absent for more than 48 hours, while able to do school work, Heads of Department will ensure:

- that work and material are set efficiently on Google Classroom, as before.
- that assessments and tasks will be submitted and marked promptly on Google Classroom.
- that where there is a need for some 'paper' book work to be done, if it could be scanned and emailed, this is ideal. If not, just post to the Head of Department at Mougins School and we'll ensure it's collected and marked.

Pastoral

When a student is absent, a specific named form tutor will be allocated to each student by the Head of Pastoral Care, Robert Cooke. The named tutor will get in touch with the student first by email, and touch base by Zoom, if the student would like to, immediately following the isolation, and then a few days later, to ensure that the student is well supported pastorally and making progress academically.

For all support, academic and pastoral, in the first instance students and parents should contact their named tutor via email.

Parents should use the named tutor as their point of contact with the school.

Primary School/EYFS

Academic

In the event that a student tests positive, but is not unwell, and thus self-isolating, or is self-isolating class teachers will ensure:

- Planning for the week is put onto Google classroom
- Planning sheets are annotated to show appropriate sites for parents to access materials and ideas for their children to do related to that week's objectives. It is recognised that much work in primary is practical and hands on, and recorded work is as a result of this. If it is appropriate specific worksheets may be posted but is not a regular expectation
- Homework for the week is put onto Google classroom

Pastoral

When a student is absent, their class teacher will get in touch with the parent by mail and will organise with them an agreed system of contact on a regular basis

For all support, academic and pastoral, in the first instance students and parents should contact their class teacher via email.

Parents should use their class teacher as their point of contact with the school.
