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Mougins School UCAS school context

Mougins School is a non-selective, co-educational school for students from age 3 - 18, which follows the English National Curriculum. Students are drawn mainly from an international expatriate community. British students constitute just under 25% of the total pupil body, with currently around 40 nationalities represented. Typically, Mougins School families move around the world and our students will most certainly have experienced several different school environments in their educational career, leading to significant disruption in the continuity of learning in many cases. An average academic year will see a 20% turnover in students, with the normal duration of stay between 3 – 5 years. English is the language of instruction at Mougins School, although only around a half of pupils speak English as a first language. Given that some of our eighty Sixth Form students will be relatively new to Mougins School, and will often speak English as an additional language, we are very proud of our high achieving academic tradition.

Students are encouraged to concentrate on four International AS-levels in the Lower Sixth followed by three A-levels in the Upper Sixth. There is some flexibility within this, with a small number of students embarking on a '3+' programme, typically adding either an own language course, or Further Mathematics to their schedule. Equally, a small number will take fewer than 3 A Levels, often supplementing these with further GCSE courses. A Level provision for the current Year 13 cohort is detailed below: Art & Design, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Drama & Theatre Studies, English Literature, French, Geography, History, History of Art, Mathematics, Physics, Spanish, Computer Science. We also offer a limited number of BTech (Music and Sports) and LAMDA courses.

A-level predicted grades are the product of discussion and assessment within subject areas, and evidence is collated to substantiate these predictions. Such evidence will include AS results, mock examination results, homework records and internal progress grades, together with a holistic view of a student's attainment throughout a course and their potential for the future.

Covid-19: due to our position in France, Mougins school entered lockdown (*confinement*) on Monday 16th March. The current Year 13 cohort therefore were taught remotely from this date until the end of their Year 12 studies on July 3rd.
