Dear Parents,

We are excited to announce that we will be beginning our Outdoor Learning lessons in our local forest behind the school from the week beginning May 3rd.

Year 1 will spend each **Tuesday morning** in the forest.

Our staff have been busy preparing resources and planning the curriculum for outdoor learning to ensure the best possible learning outcomes for the children.

To ensure the safety of our children, we are asking that all children are equipped with the following:

- A small rucksack, big enough to carry their bottle of water and a snack.
(not their school bag)
 - Suitable shoes - trainers or walking shoes / boots
 - Long trousers
 - Sun hat or cap
 - Suncream
 - Pack of antibacterial wipes

Clothes may get dirty so please keep this in mind.

Please make sure everything is labelled with your child's name. These rucksacks can be kept in school.

Children will also be given a high-visibility vest to wear.

For the children's safety, due to the nature of these outdoor activities, we will insist that the children follow strict rules such as staying within sight of the teacher and listening to instructions carefully. Failure to do

so will result in individual children not being allowed to participate in these activities. Please discuss this with your child and make sure they understand the consequences.
